



by Madeleine Walker, 2009



The Last Alchemist: Count Cagliostro, Master of Magic in the Age of Reason


A dazzling panoramic portrait of eighteenth-century European culture. McCalman documents how Cagliostro crossed paths -- and often swords -- with Catherine the Great, Marie Antoinette, and Pope Pius VI. He was a muse to William Blake and Louis XVI had him thrown into the Bastille for his alleged involvement in what would come to be known as "the affair of the necklace." Yet in London, Warsaw, and St. Petersburg, he established "healing clinics" for the poorest of the poor, a radical notion at that time; and his dexterity in the worlds of alchemy and spiritualism won him acclaim among the nobility across Europe.



The Dreaming Universe

Wolf argues that dreams are a vital aspect of evolution, enabling an individual to develop a concept of self. Our dream images, even if we don't remember them, invade our waking consciousness as patterns that shape our lives. The "imaginal realm," halfway between material and mental reality, manifests lucid dreams, near-death experiences, and possibly in UFO abductions. Wolf bolsters his thesis that dreams connect with physical reality by drawing on quantum physics, the works of Freud and Jung, modern dream research and Australian aboriginals' concept of an eternal "dreamtime."



The Mystery and Meaning of the Dead Sea Scrolls


by Hershel Shanks, 1999

Here, in arresting detail, is the most complete assessment of the scrolls to date. It is a history of their discovery and dissemination, a summary of their scholarly interpretation, and a thoughtful meditation on their ultimate significance. Above all, it is an act of generosity--a great scholar's gift to the common understanding of the most important ancient texts found in modern times. Until recently only a handful of scholars were able to view the scrolls.
