7 pm – 9 pm, Wednesdays




Rolling Thunder (1916-1997) was known for his remarkable healings and ability to call on the forces of nature. Stop the Attack on Free Internet

I'm glad you got down this far, and are reading this. You are the kind of person who probably cares about maintaining the internet as a valuable source of information.

If, like me, you are an avid reader of internet news, exposés, and reporting sites, you have noticed how stories that are fairly new, say five or six years old, disappear from the web. Very interesting and informative websites that I visited in the 1990s and early 2000s are almost all gone. We have books in our library from 60, 80, even 100 years ago, but, in contrast, the internet is ephemeral.

The internet is our global library. One of the things I've learned is that I have to download stories and media if it is something I want to be able to access later, since things just *poof!* disappear, like in George Orwell's 1984.

New proposals to the internet governing group will allow websites to put digital locks on their content, making it not only impossible to download their media, but also opening up our computers to malware and dangerous content.

This proposal, called Encrypted Media Extensions (EME) is being considered for inclusion by the governing body that controls the web, the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C). It is being pushed by the internet biggies like Netflix, Microsoft, Google and Apple.

The Free Foundation Software group is one of the organizations trying to stop this, and they need people to sign up to protest this. The article is fairly technical, so be forewarned, but the activity is worth supporting.
