Call for Board of Advisors

The AS-YOU-LIKE-IT Library has been around since 1961. About twenty years ago, the Library rebranded itself as The Seattle Metaphysical Library, to emphasize a change in the Library's central purpose.

Our whole society has changed drastically in the past sixty years. A financial crisis necessitated a move to our current Ballard location. When we were on Capitol Hill, we had four times as much floor space as we do now, and the collection was made up of material the core staff cherished.

When we moved to Ballard, we had to cull the collection, mostly discarding duplicates and triplicates. Our mission morphed into being a resource for books you cannot get at the public library.

Like the rest of America, the Seattle Public Library is changing – it has been abandoning books like crazy. We are surprised at the dearth of material on the shelves, especially the older material. The next time you are in the public library, look and see how many actual books for grown-ups are on the shelves. It's surprisingly small. This poses a dilemma for us.

We continue to get donations.

That means we need to start removing content from our shelves. The three volunteers who are the staff (Ron, Kathy, and Margaret) have been putting off doing this work for several years, but we've been told of an imminent donation of 23 boxes of books, and we have no place to put them.

Rather than just start pulling books we think are stupid off the shelves, we'd like to use this as an incentive to build the Board of Advisors and rethink our purpose and direction.

As responsible stewards, we need to expand the base of Library governance. We'd like to have more participation by people who care about our Library, and who, out of a spirit of pure altruism, can help refine and expand our vision of how we can best use our resources into the future.

In the face of the "dumbing down" of the public, we can't help but sense how powerful it might be, in the future, to maintain this collection – who knows if it will be available elsewhere? The internet is fine for buying stuff, but it's not a very good way to browse and see what's out there!

So we are starting an Advisory Board to help us focus and define the future direction of the Library. We don't have a clear direction and role for that board – to a certain extent, it will be comprised of people who care about the Library and want to see it thrive and serve a high purpose to the community. What that purpose will look like will be something the Board will help us figure out.

Volunteers Requested

We need 4 to 6 people to volunteer Thursday March 9 afternoon – evening

We will be receiving a large donation of books soon, and to fit the books in, we need to re-arrange a section of our shelves. This will involve moving books from the shelves, moving shelves and then putting the books back. Depending upon how many volunteers we have, I anticipate it will take us 3 – 5 hours.

If you would be willing to help, please reply to this newsletter. I have no idea how many, if anyone, will step forward, and we are flexible, so if you would be willing to help, but at a different time, let me know.

All life forms have the capability of responding to one another, from plants and bacteria to foods and animal cells. Most amazing is his work with human leukocytes. These discoveries have opened up a new paradigm in science, ecology and healing.

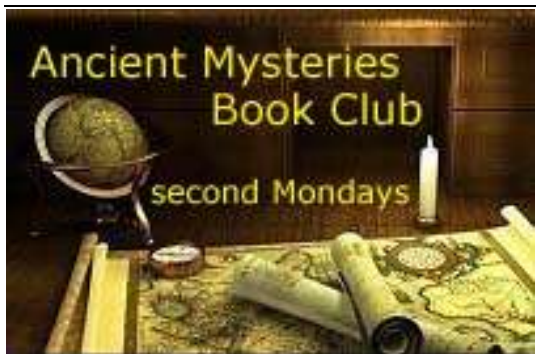

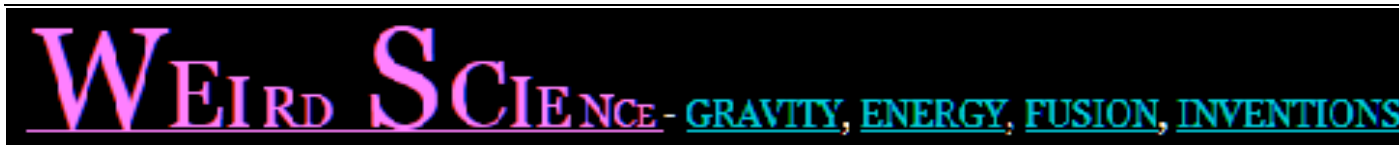
Ancient Origins Book Club

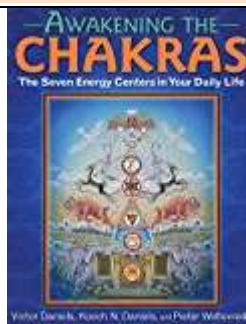

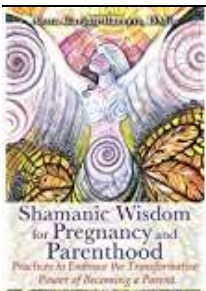

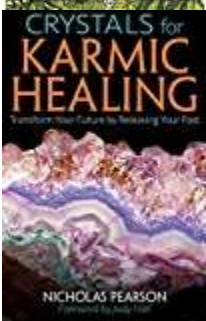
Awakening the Chakras: The Seven Energy Centers in Your Daily Life

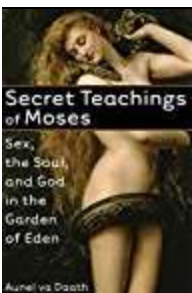

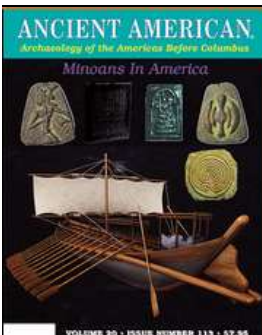

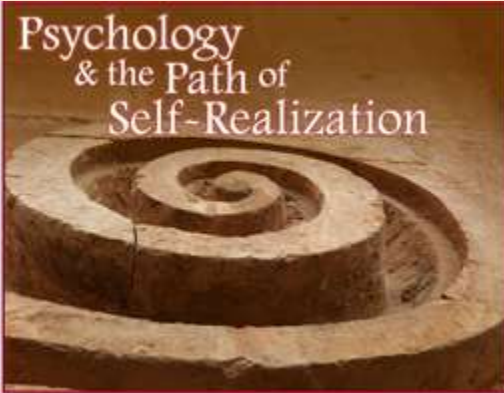
