

Our Huge Sale Continues

We have recently had two very large donations.

One is the legacy library of Janine Thompson, a long-time Library member. She had a large collection of Tarot books and decks, as well as books on Aleister Crowley, the Kabbala, astrology, runes, Wicca, Magick and the Jewish religion. These books and decks are mostly in pristine condition, a few are gently used. Not all the books will be set out at once, since there are so many. Some are still being sorted, so be sure to check back every now and then to see what's new. We are working on getting the list of books for sale on line, but even if we do, it won't be updated very often so it will be mostly a guide, rather than a shopping cart.

To make room for the new decks, we are selling some of our existing decks. Most of the decks will be priced between \$8 and \$12. We will also be selling some of the decks we have in our collection that are not complete. We use these occasionally for art projects, and we will be selling these decks for \$2 -\$3 dollars.

by B. Alan Wallace



by Ellen Evert Hopman



Included in each discussion are complete instructions on the medicinal and magical uses of the herbs associated with each celebration.

Hopman suggests ways to incorporate the symbolic and magical power of herbs into personal rituals that honor life from childbirth to last rites. Also included are chapters on how to prepare herbal tinctures, salves, and poultices; herbs used by the Druids; herbal alchemy and the planets; and the relationships between herbs and sacred places.
