We are in the process of setting up a Board of Advisors and also expanding our Board of Directors

As practically everyone who walks in our library notices, we have an incredible collection of interesting material. There is really nothing like it in the world.

Some major changes are coming up in the next period of time; we need to make some serious decisions about what direction to take the Library.

The Kress building, our current home, has been sold Our lease runs until March of 2020, when rent may well be raised to the point of being unaffordable. We will be looking to relocate in the meantime.

We will be receiving a good donation of money this fall that will give us some opportunity to take advantage of the great resource we have.

We are looking for Board members who can make a substantial contribution to the future of the Library. We are looking for people who care about the altruistic nature of our contribution to the well-being of our shared humanity, and to help individuals increase their awareness of themselves and their place in the world. The knowledge filter is strong, and getting stronger, as alternative voices become more and more lost in the public space.

We have had a very small Board, consisting only of staff members who do a regular weekly shift. However, staff time keeping the Library open is not the only contribution that our little library needs. We also need people who can provide direction and resources to take advantage of the great resource we have in our collection.

by Erika Buenaflor M.A. J.D. 2018

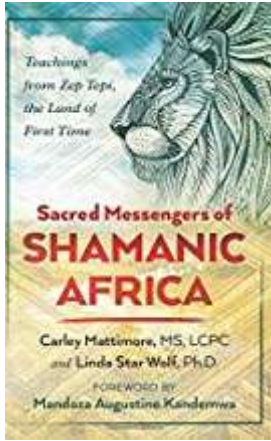

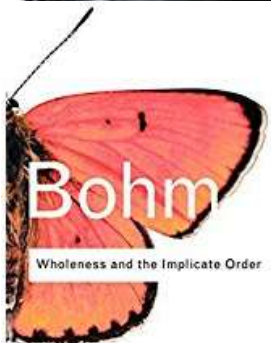

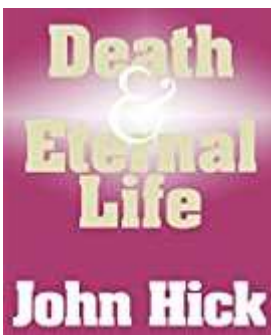


[Wholeness and the Implicate Order](#)

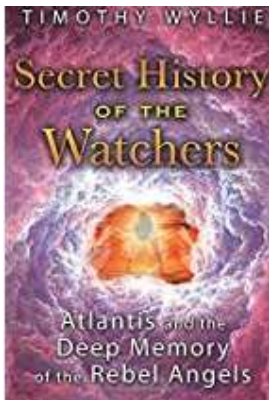
Bohm's main concern was with understanding the nature of reality in general and of consciousness in particular. In this classic work he develops a theory of quantum physics which treats the totality of existence as an unbroken whole. Writing clearly and without technical jargon, he makes complex ideas accessible to anyone interested in the nature of reality.

John Hick 1994

In this cross-cultural, interdisciplinary study, John Hick draws upon major world religions, as well as biology, psychology, parapsychology, anthropology, and philosophy, to explore the mystery of death. He argues that scientific and philosophical objections to the idea of survival after death can be challenged, and he claims that human inadequacy in facing suffering supports the basic religious argument for immortality.
